- Abstract (max. 800 characters with spaces)
- Keywords (up to 5)
- Short biography (max. 800 characters with spaces)
- Personal portrait photography
- Up to 5 photos from the presentation.

Get Accepted

- The list of speakers, the schedule of the presentations will be announced on the **23 April 2021** and programme will be promoted via various communication channels.
- All proposals will be reviewed within one week after submission.
- In case of too many presentations, a selection will be made by the organizer.

Date: 11 May 2021

Presentation at the Online Colloquium

- There will be moderator who will present you and your presentation before you will start.
- Presentation should be prepared according to the guidelines prepared by the FSK office (sent with confirmation of presentation).
- Presentation should be no longer than 10 minutes (also video materials are welcome).
- After the presentation 5 minutes time slot will be dedicated to the discussion (Q and A format also possible in parallel in chat box).
- At the end of each part of presentations all presenters will be invited to participate in the summary.
